- 4.) Appoint A Team Parent and Scorekeeper(s).
- 5.) Be present and/or make sure your team is represented at all required work parties.
- 6.) Work with TTBR officers and the Team Parent in performing all necessary and required functions.
- 7.) Be responsible for the team's equipment and return it to the designated Board Member as soon as the season is completed.
- 8.) See that all team members and their families conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner at all times.
